

## 7 Horseneck Road John Gifford House

The John Gifford house is a charming Cape Cod style house with clapboard siding and a granite foundation. Built in 1794 for Isaac Howland Jr., a whaling captain and merchant, it remained in the Howland family for the next century. It was later owned and occupied by the Read, Smith, Slocum, and Tripp families. An addition, a revised first floor plan, and a wood stove are 20<sup>th</sup> Century changes.
