
1856 MAP DARTMOUTH (CUT)




Fig. 11. The stair is original to the construction of the house; however, it has had some repairs done to it. All of the repairs remain faithful to the original design and have not detracted from the integrity of the piece.




WEST ELEVATION



Henry Howland was born in 1672 and lived in Dartmouth. He was the son of Zoeth Howland and grandson of Henry Howland, an original proprietor of Dartmouth. He married his first wife, Deborah Briggs of Dartmouth in 1698 (who died in 1712), and his second wife, Elizabeth Northrup in 1714. He had a large lumber business and was a house builder.

In 1707 he agreed to build a pound for the Town, and in 1709 he agreed to make a "pare of Stocks and Whipping posts." He held a prominent position in the Society of Friends, and was active in Town government, holding the positions of Town Treasurer in 1716 and 1722, Selectman in 1724, 1728, and 1729; and Constable in 1729.

"In his will dated August 22, 1729, he' says "my wife having unjustly departed from me and clandestinely taken with her a great part of my household goods, I give her to have and enjoy her thirds."
