## Fake Scrimshaw

Scrimshaw that is not what it purports to be. Most of these pieces are made from authentic marine mammal ivory (sperm whale teeth or walrus tusks); others are made from caribou antler or elephant ivory. They are not plastic or synthetic. However, while they may look antique, they are not authentic whaler's work, were not made on shipboard, and are not real scrimshaw. Some of them are just bad art, the innocent results of inept talent. Others are frauds, deliberately made to deceive -- shameless forgeries made to look like antiques when they are not.

This small exhibition is mounted for the museum's 14th Scrimshaw Collectors' Weekend, being held during 28 June - 1 July 2002.

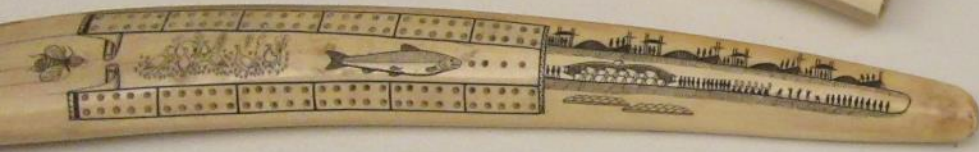

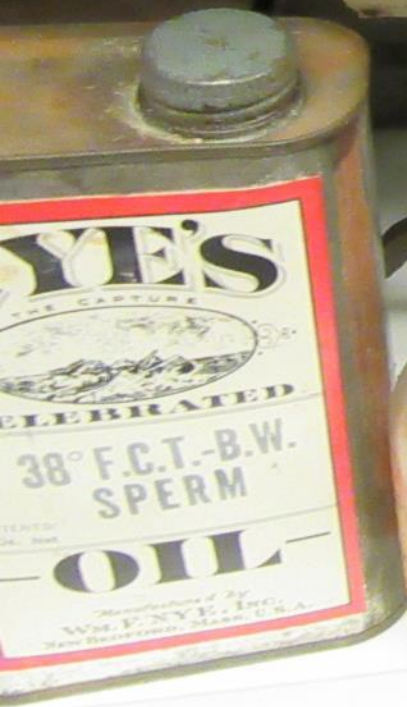

Thomas Bennett (1790-1865) was a merchant captain in the Black Ball packet service between New York and Liverpool, commanding ten voyages between 1825 and the mid-1830s. In this view, Captain Bennett is shown with a sea chart and a kit of drafting tools. Such kits were the tools of a professional navigator including slide rules for calculations and various sized dividers and other implements for plotting measurements. An example of such a kit is on display in the case at right.
